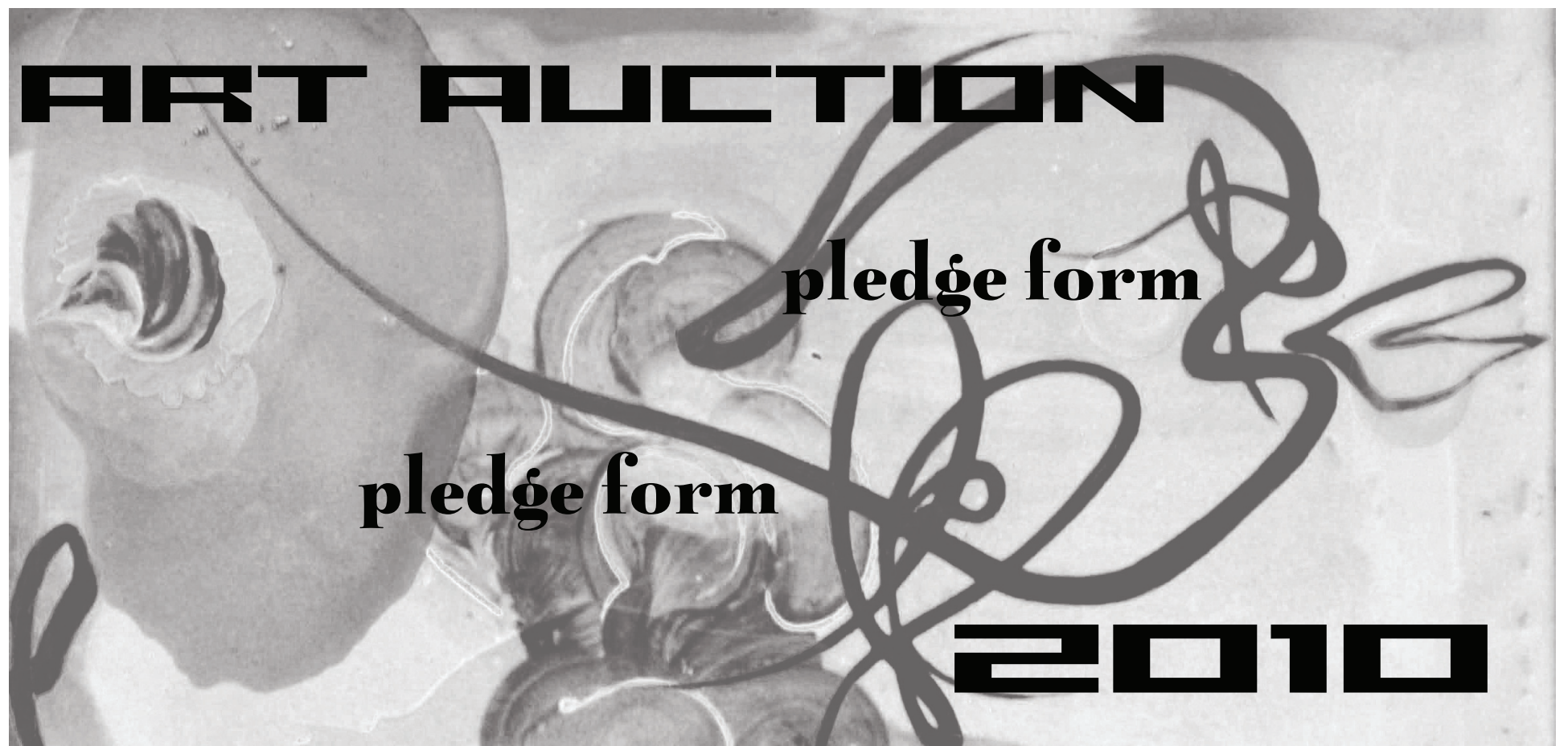

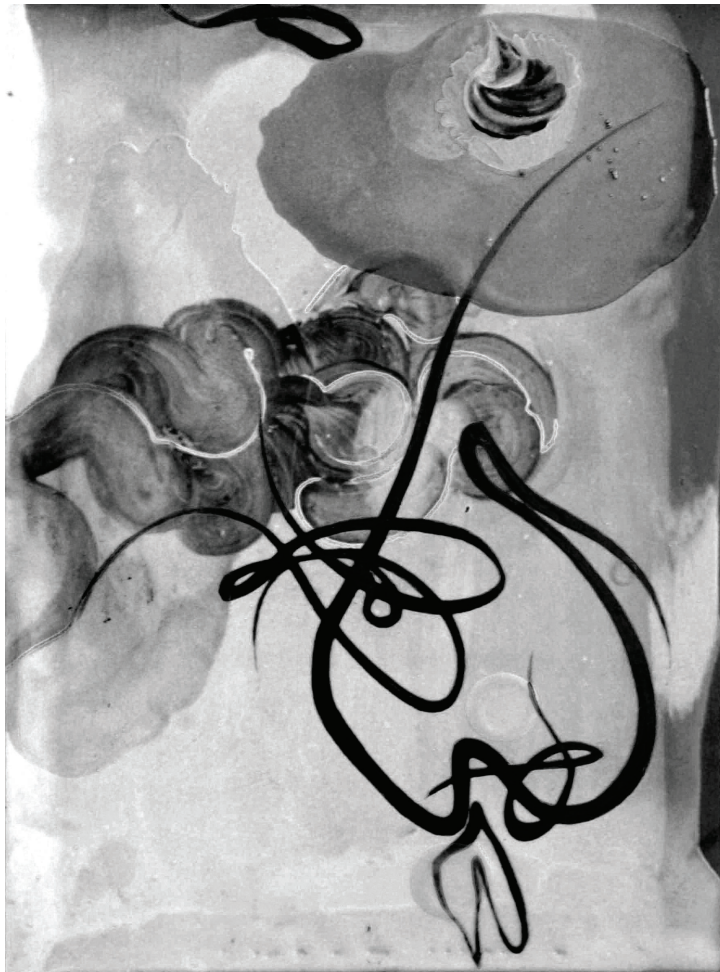
### THE KANSAS CITY ARTISTS COALITION

- EXHIBITIONS**  
Artists are the key. The Artists Coalition's support of artistic expression comes in all forms. We show artists with national reputations; emerging artists who are gaining recognition; and artists who are building their careers. We show artists from across the US, our region and our city.
- GRANTS**  
The Lighton International Artists Exchange Program, begun in 2002 with a generous grant from the Lighton Fund, provides support for visual artists to travel to international residencies and artist communities. The M.A.P. Grant, or Money for Artists Promotion assists artists by providing funds to promote and market their artwork.
- ARTISTS RESIDENCY**  
Opening in 2010, the Kansas City Artists Residency Program is located down the hall from the KCAC Galleries. The Residency Program offers dedicated individuals a supportive environment in which to further their creative development, and provides a resource of time and space for artists to create their best work.
- PROMOTION**  
The Artists Coalition web site is a comprehensive listing of member artists, images of their work, artist opportunities, grants, residencies, and more. The KCAC web site routinely receives over 2 million hits per year. Artists Studios:KC, was published in the fall of 2009. The book includes artwork, artists' statements and contact information and is a valuable resource for finding artists. Available at the Artists Coalition.
- TOOLKITS**  
Artists Toolkits assist artists by providing a way to gain skills and take their career to a higher level. New toolkits on marketing, public art, online applications and more will be offered in the spring of 2010.

**{ you make it happen! }**

◆ Donating artists will receive one free ticket to the Auction, two free tickets to the Sweetheart Reception, a website listing in the Auction Program, a tax receipt for your records and after the auction, a letter informing you who purchased your piece and a listing of Auction Bidders.

◆ 2-D work must be ready to hang (framed and wired). We request that plexi-glass be used rather than glass to ensure the safety of the piece and the art handlers. We regret that we cannot accept reproductions of artwork or work framed with uni-frames.

◆ 3-D pieces should be sturdy with no delicate parts or appendages and must be delivered in a reusable cardboard carton.

◆ Artists pledging artwork by January 6, 2010 will have their names appear on the Auction Announcement.

◆ Pledges after January 6, 2010 may not appear in the Auction Announcement but will be in the Auction Program.

◆ Pledges are accepted **even if you are not sure which piece** you wish to donate or for which job you wish to volunteer!
