Artists

We ask you only give only one piece to the auction (pick the best!). Pick one piece that really represents your work and it will stand on its own.

We are asking that you give us the current retail price for your artwork (what it would be listed for in a retail gallery, not lower or higher than actual).

Why?

- We want bidders to understand the real dollar value of the artwork you are giving.
- Correctly valued artwork helps us as we work to inform and grow a buying audience for local artists' work.
- Bidders will use the price for insurance evaluation.
- Funders will see the true value of the artists' support of KCAC, an important consideration when they evaluate their charitable giving.

As always

- Donating artists will receive one free ticket to the Auction, two free tickets to the Sweetheart Reception, a tax receipt for your records and after the Auction, a letter informing you who purchased your piece and a listing of Auction bidders.
- Artists pledging artwork by 12/21/11 will have their names listed on the Auction Announcement. Pledges received after that date may not appear in the Auction Announcement, but will be in the Auction Program. Pledges are accepted even if you are not sure which piece you will donate or where you want to volunteer!
- 2-D work must be ready to hang (framed and wired). We request that plexi-glass be used rather than glass to ensure the safety of the piece and the art handlers.
- 3-D pieces should be sturdy with no delicate parts or appendages and should be delivered in a re-usable cardboard carton (so it can be packed safely to send home with the buyer).
- We regret that we cannot accept reproductions of artwork or work framed with uni-frames.
