SEALED BID AUCTION RULES

1. The Kansas City Artists Coalition (“KCAC”) is conducting a sealed bid auction of Artist-in-Residence Bai Ming’s Four Seasons (the “Artwork”).
2. KCAC has established a reserve price for the Artwork. The Artwork will not be sold if all bids submitted are less than the reserve price.
3. Bidders must purchase a ticket to the KCAC’s 2014 Annual Benefit Art Auction and obtain a bidder number. Tickets for the auction cost \$25. Tickets and Bidder Numbers may be purchased by phone.
4. All bidders must submit a deposit of at least 20% of their bid amount. Accepted forms of payment for the deposit and purchase price are Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover, Personal or Business Check, Cashier’s Check or Money Order. KCAC will return deposits to the unsuccessful bidders and will not process credit card payments submitted by unsuccessful bidders.
5. All bids must be submitted on the Sealed Bid Form attached to these rules, which must be fully completed and signed by the bidder. The Sealed Bid Form and deposit payment must be placed in a sealed envelope with the bidder’s name, bidder number and “Sealed Bid for KCAC Bai Ming Artwork Auction” printed on the outside of the envelope.
6. Bidders may submit bids either in person at KCAC’s office or by mail to 201 Wyandotte, Kansas City, Missouri, 64105. In person bids must be placed in the sealed bid auction box at KCAC’s office before 7:45pm on February 15, 2014. Mailed bids must be received by KCAC on or before February 14, 2014.
7. KCAC will open the sealed bids after 7:45pm on February 15, 2014. If two or more bidders submit the highest bid, the bid that was received first will take precedence. KCAC will announce the successful bidder number at the beginning of the Live Auction. If the bidder is not present KCAC will contact the successful bidder by telephone on February 16, 2014.
8. The successful bidder shall pay the entire bid amount on or before February 16, 2014. The successful bidder shall be responsible for picking up the Artwork from KCAC’s office at a time and date determined by the parties. If payment of the purchase price is paid by personal or business check, the Artwork may not be picked up until the check has cleared and the funds are available to KCAC.
9. By signing and submitting a bid to purchase the Artwork, the bidder acknowledges and agrees that (i) the estimated value of the Artwork provided by KCAC does not constitute a representation or warranty by KCAC of the market value of the Artwork, (ii) the bidder has had an opportunity to fully inspect the Artwork, (iii) the bidder’s bid amount was based solely on the bidder’s own independent judgment of the value of the Artwork to bidder and (iv) the Artwork is being sold “AS IS” without any warranty, express or implied.
10. KCAC reserves the right to accept or reject any bids submitted at its sole discretion.
